Parade entry fees: (no refunds)

- Early registration (entries received on or before July 31) \$25**
- Late registration (entries received after July 31 or at line up) \$35** (no announcement available on Main St)

If there is more than one (1) vehicle in your organization or business, add \$10 to the entry fee. No refunds. Your parade number will be given to you at parade check-in. Parade entries do not proceed in numerical order. Line up is based on the type of entry you have.

A BIG THANK YOU to all who participated in the parade last year. We continue to have great parades. We expect this year to be the best yet! This year's theme is **BEACH PARTY IN KUNA!**"

The Parade entry fee this year will be \$25.00 for entries received on or before July 31, 2018 and \$35.00 for entries received after July 31, 2018. If you are entering more than one vehicle for your Organization or Business, please add \$10 to the entry fee. Please indicate on your entry form how many vehicles there will be, this will help in our line-up process.

The line-up will be in the Kuna Middle School parking lot. **Please read the parade rules letter.** Registration will start at 8:00 a.m. sharp and end at 9:15 a.m. sharp. The parade is scheduled to be on Main Street at 10:00 a.m. so we need to leave the parking lot by 9:45 a.m. to be at Main St. by 10:00 a.m.

The judges may walk around the line-up area judging all entries so it's very important for all entries to be at the Middle School and in place by 9:15 a.m. The alternative is the judges will be near the announcer on Main Street. The award ceremony will be at 2:00 p.m. in the City Park at the band shell. All winners will be contacted by phone by 1:00 p.m. Please make sure the contact information on your entry form is a good contact number for the day of the parade.

Awards will be for 1st place and 2nd place for each Category, Best Overall and Judges Choice.

If you are pre-registered you will be given your number at the registration booth the morning of the parade and directed to your area for line up. We do not line up in numerical order. Number is for announcer identification and judging purposes only. If you are not registered you will need to fill out the entry form and pay the late entry fee at the registration booth before moving into the line-up area. To make things more efficient its best that you mail your entry form in before the parade day. All mailed entries should be received on or before Tuesday, July 31, 2018.

Again this year, Kuna & area Fire Departments will bring up the end of the parade with a water fight. Parade participants are welcome to join us. Let us know at line up so we can put you right before the Fire Department. Remember spectators are known to bring their own water and fire back!

Directions to the Middle School for parade entries: go west on Deer Flat Rd. off of Hwy 69 (Kuna-Meridian Hwy) to Ten Mile Rd., turn south towards Boise St. Turn east into the Kuna Middle School Parking Lot between the tennis courts and the softball fields. You will see the Middle School parking lot. There is no parking at the Middle School. Please park to the north at Initial Point High School for any vehicles not in the parade. **(All entries will need to enter here at the West end of the school. Please read the parade rules).**

Kuna Days Parade Rules

- *Please plan ahead and enter the staging area from the far West entrance north of Boise St. on Ten Mile Road between the Kuna Middle School softball fields and the tennis courts.*
- *All participants in the parade are responsible for making sure their staging area is cleaned up after the parade.*
- *If you have more than one vehicle in your entry please don't enter the line up area until all your vehicles have arrived so we are sure there is room for you to be together in the staging area and in the parade.*
- *Candy or advertisements are allowed but you must have individuals to walk along the parade route handing it out. (Due to the liability we don't want the children running into the street for candy)*
- *It is very important to be at the staging area early and set up by 9:15 am sharp.*
- *If you are an Organization or Church group it would be best to car pool to the Middle School or meet in a general area in town and travel to the Middle School as a group. There is no non-parade participate parking at the Middle School. Please park at Initial Point or the tennis court parking lot on Ten Mile Road. Vehicles not in the parade will not be allowed in the Middle School Parking lot. Boise Street will be closed from Ten Mile to School Street.*
- ***Please be courteous and patient with other participants and attentive to your child/children.***
- *It is important there are no large gaps between parade entries. There should be 15 to 25 feet between each entry. Please maintain this distance between you and the entry immediately in front of you.*
- *The Parade Announcer will be located on Main Street in front of the Community Hall and will introduce each entry with information provided (except for day of parade registrations). If you would like to provide information about your organization or entry, please include it with your registration or email it to information@kunachamber.com.*

Horse Entries (new unloading location this year)

- *The horse entries will be unloading at the west end parking lot of the Middle School. Please enter off Ten Mile between the tennis courts and the softball fields. Park in the parking lot to the east of the softball fields. Please check in at registration in front of the school near the Kuna Police Station.*
- *All horse participants are responsible for cleaning up the staging area after the parade. We will not have pooper scoopers. So please be courteous and help clean up before you leave for the day.*
